### ***Instructions***

#### **STEP 1: PAYMENT**

If you are reading this, then you have most likely paid your **NON-REFUNDABLE** \$200 camp fee. (YAY!!!)

#### **STEP 2: MEDICAL FORMS**

Please fill out the appropriate medical form\* given to you when you paid your deposit. If you require another copy, it will be available via the BSOC website:

Please find out about your Medicare card and Private health fund info as the medical form is to be given to us ASAP (by Tuesday 2 March – Week 1) otherwise we will have deemed you to have forfeited your position and we will fill it. Hand in your completed medical form to the BSOC Stall during O-Week or at the BSOC Office – Quadrangle Room 1025 – during Week 1.

**\*if you are a minor, you are required to fill out the medical form for under 18s.**

You are permitted to BYO (obviously an appropriate amount).

## ***Transport***

Please take note that all transport costs (bus and ferry) are included in the camp fee.

### **GETTING THERE (Friday, March 5):**

- Meet at the Physics Lawn (behind Old Main Building) near Gate 14, Barker Street by 11:00am  
Please arrive on time as we incur additional costs for delayed boarding time.
- Ferry from Brooklyn Wharf to Milsons Island  
You will have approximately 1 hour free time for lunch. There are shops at the wharf where you can purchase food.

### **GETTING BACK (Sunday, March 7):**

- Ferry from Milsons Island to Brooklyn Wharf at 3:00pm
- Bus from Brooklyn Wharf to UNSW; you will arrive back at UNSW roughly around 5-6:00 pm  
There is an option to catch a train from Brooklyn Wharf at your own cost. (Students living in the North Shore can get back earlier this way.)

## ***Rules***

These rules are set up for everyone to enjoy every minute of camp. We are now university students and understand how to respect others and to take responsibility of our own actions.

- By law there are noise restrictions in place after 12AM. However this only restricts EXCESSIVE noise, which may travel across the river and disturb neighbouring islands. As long as we are careful with our noise levels this would not affect us.

## ***What to Bring***

- YOUR COSTUME! (Theme is "When I Grow Up"! Dress in an occupation that you're not going to be – don't come in a suit and tie, there will be plenty of time for that in the next few years, and you'll get it dirty!)
